Home Care & Nursing Home Costs



Navigating the complexities of long-term care can be an overwhelming experience for many Americans, whether for themselves or their loved ones. The New York State Department of Financial Services points out that there are several care options available, such as assisted living facilities, nursing homes, and home care. For instance, in New York, the average annual cost for nursing home care is around \$159,000 per individual. Even home care, frequently viewed as a more personalized option, averages nearly \$66,000 each year. In 2018, out-of-pocket expenses for long-term care soared to an incredible \$55 billion, which is significantly less than the estimated \$159 billion spent by Medicaid. It's crucial to understand that you're not alone in facing these obstacles. Many individuals find themselves in similar situations, working hard to ensure quality care while also considering financial factors. RES Home Care currently provides an Aging at Home Program aimed at assisting families with resources to achieve long-term financial stability.

THE VISIONARY BEHIND THE SCENES Dr. Joseph Vollaro



I can hardly believe that it has been 25 years since the establishment of RES! Looking back on this journey, it all began with my choice to pursue a Ph.D. in Neuropsychology. As a young adult, I devoted much of my time to working with runaway and abused children, and as I progressed toward my doctorate, I envisioned specializing in pediatric neuropsychology.

During my doctoral studies, I completed various clinical training rotations, one of which was on an inpatient traumatic brain injury (TBI) unit at Kingsbrook Jewish Medical Center in Brooklyn, New York, mentored by Dr. Thomas Mayer. Although I initially felt nervous due to my lack of experience with TBI, I quickly discovered a profound passion for the field. This enthusiasm prompted me to undertake a second rotation there, leading me to reevaluate my long-term focus on brain injury rehabilitation.

A crucial turning point in RES's development came from practical needs. Pursuing my Ph.D. was a full-time endeavor that required significant work to support myself. I joined a CUNY-sponsored program that guided Ph.D. students considering academia, allowing me to teach undergraduate courses while in graduate school. Additionally, a former graduate from the neuropsychology program reached out to our department chair, seeking graduate students for his agency focused on repatriating New York State residents who had been institutionalized out of state, marking the start of the TBI waiver initiative. Eager to apply my growing interest and experience in brain injury, I accepted a position as what is now called a Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) worker. Remarkably, 25 years later, I still maintain connections with many individuals I met during this formative time.

After completing my Ph.D., my wife Maureen, a social worker, and I launched a private practice in Clinical Neuropsychology. Our expertise led to numerous referrals for individuals with traumatic brain injuries, many of whom were part of the TBI waiver program. Recognizing a growing need, we founded an agency dedicated to assisting TBI survivors in achieving independence within their communities. This endeavor deepened my involvement in state-level program development to address emerging gaps, broadened our agency's services, and resulted in the establishment of the RES Community Center and our largest department, RES Home Care. Reflecting on this journey, I feel incredibly fortunate to have participated in such a meaningful process. A highlight has been collaborating with numerous dedicated professionals who share a commitment to this vital work. Many have become long-term RES employees and valued colleagues. It has been an honor to witness their professional growth and continue serving many RES Community Members over the years.

As we celebrate this significant milestone, I am excited to announce upcoming events at the RES Community Center, located at 1461 Lakeland Avenue, Suite 12, Bohemia, NY 11716. In collaboration with the Alzheimer's Association, we are offering free educational classes designed for caregivers and families:
